

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Natural overcalls, usually 5-card or good 4-card
Responses natural, not forcing. Cuebid forcing.
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
16(15)-18 HCP, usually with a stopper
Responses: Stayman, Jacoby transfers
The same by reopening
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Natural 6+ card, not forcing
Responses natural, not forcing
Unusual NT with 2 lower unbid suits
Reopen:
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Always: 2♣ = Capelletti (any onesuiter)
2♦,2♥,2♠ = DONT: the named suit and a higher suit (or ♣)
Double: at least the same strength as opp's 1NT, usu. for penalty
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
Double is takeout, Lebensohl
Cue bid – very strong, unbalanced hand
NT natural with a stopper
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
Redouble is strong, 11+ HCP
New suit and jump shifts natural, not forcing
