OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
1-level: 5+suit, 7+pts
2-level: 5+suit, 11+pts
Jump overcalls: Immediate = Weak, Reopening = Min. Opening
Reopening Overcalls: 3 points weaker, Advancer responds as if weaker
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2nd: 15-18 bal
4th live: 4-5 other two suits
reopening: 11-14 bal
Responses as if over 1NT opening
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Weak jump overcall immediate
Responses as if over Weak 2
Unusual NT, Lowest 2 unbid suits
Reopen: 13-15, 6+suit

2H = 0-6 pts, 3+H

2S = fit-jump (4+H, 5+S)

If M = S:

2D = 6+pts, 5+H, no 3S

2H = 7+pts, 3S

2S = 0-6 pts, 3+S
