Normal 5+ cards 7+ points
2 level usually 6+ cards and a decent hand
New suit 10+ forcing one round
Cuebid in opponent's suit shows support and 10+
Jump raise shows 6-9 points and 4/5 card support
Splinters
INT OVERCALL (2 nd /4 th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-17 bal
Full system on
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Weak 4-10
